We are required to collect some personal information from you to receive funding for the services we provide.

Information that we collect is important to:

- continue to get money for homeless services
- get more money for services for homeless persons
- make it easier for homeless persons to get services
- make services for homeless persons better
- understand the needs of homeless persons better

We only collect information that is appropriate for the services you are requesting.

The HMIS System will not give your personal information to anyone without your permission.

This Agency may ask to share your personal information with other agencies to better serve you.

Please ask us about how we keep your information confidential.
